 - ETIs are expected to become Technical Committees (TCs) when the area is consolidated
 - Currently there are 27 TCs
 - ETI's goal is to foster research and innovation around design, developments, and evaluation of sound-based communication
 - Main technical areas of Interest: Smart Sound Things, Networking, Applications and services, Datasets and storage,
 - Non-technical areas of interest: Artistic aspects of IoS, Responsible and ethical research and innovation for the IoS
 - In Summary, the IoS is a highly interdisciplinary field of research
 - Currently, there is a subpage for this IEEE COMSOC ETI
