  - IoS Research Network: steady growth of partners (+9%) and mailing list subscribers (+8%)
  - 220% more submissions to IS2 2023 compared to 2022
  - attention to products related to technology that support Network Music Performances
  - Still lots of room to grow the community

- 62 in-person attendees, 11 remote participants
- 86 paper submissions, 54% accepted
- Proceedings submitted to IEEEXplore
- catering provided by socially responsible organization for people with disadvantages

  - 5 presentations, 2 posters, 5 demos
  - 1 panel with 6 experts from academia and industry
  - Tutorial by university spin-off Atmoky
  - report submitted to ComSoc and approved by ComSoc (grant received)

  - 3-day event in Erlangen, Germany (Sep 30 Oct 2 2024)
  - Location: Fraunhofer Institute for Integrated Circuits IIS

  - Call for submissions includes Music and Sound Installations in addition to technical Papers and Demos
  - Expecting 80 100 attendees
